Consideration of Increasing School Lunch Prices

Mrs. Kris Albrecht, Millard School District Child Nutrition Director, met with the Members of the Board to review the need to recommend that the prices for school lunch meals be raised. This is a result of an audit by the State Child Nutrition program.

Consideration to Increase the Price of School Lunch

The current prices for school lunch are:

Elementary students: \$2.25 Middle School Students: \$2.50 High School students: \$2.75

These school lunch prices have not been increased since June 2011 for the 2011-2012 school year.

It was recommended that the school lunch prices be increased by \$0.25 for all student meals for the following:

Elementary students: \$2.50 Middle School students: \$2.75 High School students: \$3.00

This recommendation will be brought back for action in the June Board of Education meeting.

Delta High School - Proposal for Drug Testing Policy

Mrs. Teresa Thompson, Principal of Delta High School, met with the Members of the Board to review, discuss, and request the Board of Education consider the implementation of a Drug Testing Policy.

It was suggested that an educational drug testing policy for all students in grades nine (9) through twelve (12) who participate in extracurricular activities is advisable for the following reasons:

1. <u>Health and safety of the individual and others.</u> Any student participating in an activity under the influence of an illegal drug or alcohol creates a risk of death or serious bodily injury, not only to the student, but to other participants and spectators.

- 2. <u>Prevention.</u> Many students will be able to say no to drugs because they will have an additional reason (i.e. participation in a student activity program) to avoid the use of drugs.
- 3. <u>Intervention</u>. Individuals desiring to participate in activities will seek professional, parental, or clerical assistance for their drug or alcohol problems.

Before any student participates in a Utah High School Activities Association (UHSAA) extracurricular program, the student and the student's custodial parent or lawful guardian shall execute and deliver to their local high school a written consent. Random testing will be conducted during the season on a weekly basis or any other frequency determined by the district.

This matter will be reviewed with legal counsel, with a recommendation made to the Board of Education for further consideration.

Request to Increase Extra-Duty Pay for School Musical

Mrs. Audrey Stephenson and Mrs. Winter Rowley, Directors of Delta High School's school musicals, request that the pay for the director be increased to the same as a head coach (currently \$3,142) and that an assistant director be added to the Extra-Duty Salary Schedule at the same rate as an assistant coach (currently \$1,886).

Request for Adjustment to MSD Extra-Duty Pay

The reasons given were: Increased program enrollment and retention; Increased time commitment; and Increased school revenue and visibility.

This matter will be reviewed further and possibly brought back as an action item for a future Board of Education meeting.

Review of Millard School District Audit Committee

The Members of the Board reviewed this and made suggestions of possible members of the community that could be asked to serve on the Millard School District Audit Committee.
